BOMB

We offer a range of fun team building challenges designed to reinforce teamwork and communication skills. A large number of challenges are mobile and suitable as both outdoor and indoor activities. Book a three hour programme with 3 activities at £70 + VAT or full day at £110 + VAT per person (group size: 12-100 participants).

ROCKET:

Design, build and test an air-powered rocket, lots of opportunities to evaluate performance, modify and re-launch until you finally reach the target

ESCAPE:

Using only the equipment provided the whole team must negotiate their way over the minefield and retrieve the designated equipment within the time given.

RESCUE BARBIE:

Save Barbie from the shark infested island in the quickest time. Team members will be blindfolded and have to coordinate together to save Barbie within the time given.

COUNTDOWN:

Working against the clock teams have to retrieve sufficient liquid to recover the key and open the safe, before the alarm sounds.

WIZARD:

Teams are given a set of photographs taken around the venue - they have to find the site of each photograph and copy down the information displayed there. All the information once received is a brainteaser about Gandalf the wizard and his village friends.

BLIND SHEEP:

All the team members, except the shepherd, are blindfolded. The shepherd is then given the challenge of herding all the sheep through a maze, using only the communication tools provided.

BOMB:

The team is challenged to burst the balloons and recover the eggs within them (unbroken of course). There are constraints, not least the fact that the balloons are suspended in a no go area.

BALLISTA:

Design and build a giant missile launcher, capable of firing a water filled balloon at the target.

GOLD RUSH:

A pile of seemingly useless equipment is presented to the team. The challenge is to build a system capable of transporting the liquid gold through the course without any spillage. Design and building will be crucial to achieving success.

WALKING SKI RACE:

The ultimate test of team co-ordination, as the whole team has to negotiate the course in the quickest time.

MOTORISED BEER KEGS:

Each team has a practice run, before the race around the slalom course with pit stops F1 style. Exciting to ride, hilarious to watch.

MOTORISED BATH TUBS

Yet another invention to match the Motorised beer kegs, the bath tubs have both forward and reverse gears and make for a very enjoyable experience.

SEGWAYS:

The ultimate off road personal transporters are easy to master after a practice session with the instructor. Teams then compete head to head driving through the slalom course to achieve the quickest time.

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MOTORISED BATH TUBS

HUMAN TABLE FOOTBALL:

A hilarious game of 5/6-a-side with contestants only able to move side ways along the poles wearing a special harness, a great game with foam balls used for safety.

AIR RIFLE SCRABBLE:

After a team practice, each player must shoot at the alphabet target; any letters hit are then used to make as many words as possible on the board to achieve a team score.

ARCHERY:

Try your skill at this sport, suitable for beginners or keen archers. After a practice session its time to shoot for a team or individual score.

TARGET GOLF:

A team game for anyone, whether total beginner or a keen golfer, hit the balls on the target and score the team points, practice balls are used for safety.

SUMO WRESTLING:

Wearing a huge padded sumo wrestler suit, grapple with your opponent and shove them out of the ring, first to finish 3 bouts is the champion.

CROSSBOWS:

These weapons date back 2,000 years. Try your hand at shooting the 5 inch bolt at the bulls-eye target with an instructor next to you. A steady hand will be required to score in the Gold centre.

BUBBLE FOOTBALL

An action packed activity where 2 teams of 5 payers are encased in an inflatable bubble, players will battle it out for possession of the ball to score the goals and win the game. this is a physical activity the same as playing 5 a side football and participants should be physically fit.

SHELTER OR FENCE BUILDING

Teams work together using traditional willow wands to create a shelter and fence that can be used to protect them from the elements. They will then cover their shelters with plastic sheeting and camouflage so that it blends into the environment. Full instructions and support will be provided by our bushcraft experts.

SIGNAL TOWER

A great team activity, against the clock. Which team can take, the poles and rope provided and produce a free standing tower in the shortest time. Teams will need to include a device for raising and lowering a signal lamp, and the winning team will be the first to have their lamp raised 4 metres off the ground.

All activities are outdoor, the following are indoor as well:
