## You have a choice of the following courses. Please tick which course you would like to play.

- CARNOUSTIE GOLF LINKS - SCOTLAND**  
The game of golf has been played in Carnoustie for over 400 years
- COG HILL, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - USA**  
The heavily bunkered, large greened famous Dubsdread Course is rated the best course in Illinois
- CONGRESSIONAL COUNTRY CLUB, MARYLAND - USA**  
World famous course where Rory McIlroy won the US Open in 2011
- HAZLETINE NATIONAL GOLF CLUB, MINNESOTA - USA**  
With the 2016 Ryder Cup, Hazeltine will become one of only two courses in the United States to have hosted the U.S. Open, PGA Championship, U.S. Senior Open, U.S. Women's Open, U.S. Amateur, and Ryder Cup Matches. Plenty of bunkers, trees and water hazards.
- KINGSBARNES - SCOTLAND**  
A classic Scottish links course considered the 8th best course outside the US.
- OAKMONT COUNTRY CLUB, PENNSYLVANIA - USA**  
Hosted more major championship courses than any other US course. 210 bunkers, tight fairways - a tough challenge. 4th toughest course in the US.
- ROYAL BIRKDALE 2012, MERSEYSIDE - ENGLAND**  
A great links course voted the best course in Britain and one of the finest in the world.
- ROYAL TROON, Ayrshire - SCOTLAND**  
One of the great Scottish links courses - hosting the Open Championship for the 8th time in 2016
- SCHAUMBERG, MEDINAH, ILLINOIS - USA**  
Scene of the famous Miracle at Medinah Ryder Cup in 2012, this course is a challenge for any golfer with lots of water to contend with - especially the signature #5
- SONOMA SHORES, NAPA, CALIFORNIA - USA**  
An excellent course with rolling terrain highlighted by massive oaks, lakes and sweeping vistas of the Mayacamas Mountains and neighboring vineyards. There's a great balance and blend of long and short holes.
- SUNNINGDALE COUNTRY CLUB 2011, BERKSHIRE - ENGLAND**  
A famous club since 1900, Sunningdale is blessed with a championship course laid out on the most glorious piece of heathland winding its way through heather, gorse and pine.
- THE CELTIC MANOR RESORT 2010, NEWPORT - WALES**  
Built to stage The 2010 Ryder Cup, the first course to be built specifically for golf's greatest team tournament, the course has water hazards on half of its holes. It has six signature holes and presents many more memorable tests and risk-and-reward dilemmas.
- TURNBURY (AILSA COURSE), Ayrshire - SCOTLAND**  
Your chance to play one of Donald Trump's courses without necessarily supporting or endorsing his political views or aspirations. The course is demanding with magnificent coastal scenery and the 9th hole, with its view of the ruins of Bruce's Castle is the trademark hole.
- WARWICKSHIRE BRABAZON (THE BELFRY), WEST MIDLANDS - ENGLAND**  
Playing a round at The Belfry is a real treat for any golfer. Known as the 'spiritual' home to the Ryder Cup, having held the prestigious tournament four times. The signature hole is the 10th, a unique short par 4 with water running along the right hand side of the fairway. Made famous in the 1985 Ryder Cup when golf legend Seve Ballesteros twice drove the green, it has truly become one of the most memorable holes in golf.
- WARWICKSHIRE NATIONAL, WARWICKSHIRE - ENGLAND**  
The course offer the perfect challenge for golfers of all abilities, having hosted many professional tournaments including a European Seniors Tour and the Midland PGA Final.

## You also have the choice of the following Game Options. Please tick which you would like to play

- STROKE PLAY**  
Score is kept by adding the number of strokes taken per hole. Lowest score wins.
- STABLEFORD**  
Points are awarded relative to par and based on your handicap
- MODIFIED STABLEFORD**  
Points are awarded relative to par and based on your handicap - this system rewards better play (5 points for an eagle) but also penalizes poor play (-3 points for a double bogey)
- MATCH PLAY**  
Win a hole to score a point - 2 players only
- SKINS**  
Each hole has a value (the skin) and when players tie the value rolls over to the next hole. A win takes the value of the next hole back down to one.
- TEXAS SCRAMBLE**  
Good fun for team play - but no gimmies or mulligans (free shots) allowed. Each player takes a shot and you pick the best lie for your next shot.

## Other options

We recommend that you select 6ft "gimmies" (so, if your ball lands within 6ft of the hole, the system will take it that you only require one more putt to complete it). For a quicker game, select 10ft "gimmies" and for a lightening round without the hassle of putting select "Auto Putt" and "Double Par" for the maximum number of strokes to play.

We suggest you leave the weather conditions and other settings at default for non-serious play with large groups but you are most welcome to select an
